Files on student Google Accounts:

Google accounts for those students returning in the fall will NOT be deleted or deactivated. Students will keep their Google accounts (and Chromebooks) including all files & email contained in their Google accounts, until they

graduate.

Graduating students will have their network and Google accounts deactivated on August 1st. Please let your senior students know that if they wish to take their Google files with them, they should follow the directions specified at the bottom of our technology page on the D120.org website: http://www.d120.org/technology under the "Seniors: Export your Google Data!" section.

Files on student H: Drives:

Every summer <u>we clear all student files</u> that reside on their H: drives. Please remind your students that if they wish to keep any of these files, they need to copy them to their own personal flash drives or upload them to their Google drives before their last day of school.



Boys Track & Field Coaches Corner

Our Mustangs exceeded our goals last night at the Conference track meet, as we took 5th with 54.5 points at the Varsity level. Things got started with the 4 x 800 relay taking 5th. Logan Ramirez, Tom Russ, Mariano Rodriguez, and Nick Schwenk combined to run 8:57.77, and got us our first 2 points of the day. We really started to cook when the 4 x 100 relay took to the track. Reece Dylan Cruz, Julian Eagar, Nick Selimos, and Marcel Siepko took 2nd, dropping another .7 seconds from our season's best, and dropping under the State Qualifying Standard of 42.99 for the first time, running 42.92. Alberto Diaz kept things moving in the 3200, running a brilliant tactical race and taking 3rd in 10:03. Tyler Miller got us another point in the 110HH, with a 6th place finish. The 100m brought us another 8 points as Marcel Siepko and Reece Cruz, seeded 4th and 6th, took 3rd and 5th, running 11.26 and 11.39. Javy Mata contributed a 6th place finish in the 800m, running 2:01.52. Our 4 x 100 relay returned for an encore in the 4 x 200, taking 4th in 1:33.33. Connor Tector narrowly missed placing in the 400m with a PR of 53.40. Tyler Miller returned in the 300m hurdles with another 6th place finish, running 44.09. Alberto Diaz came back with a 5th place finish in the 1600m, running a PR of 4:41.35. Marcel Siepko followed that up with an amazing race in the 200m, taking 2nd with another PR of 22.53. I don't know how you do that in your 4th race of the day. In the Field Events, Kevin Moyer tied for 6th in the HJ with a leap of 5'7". Nico Osorio continued to show improvement in the Pole Vault, taking 5th with a PR of 9' in his first month in the event. And the Big Guy, well....

After having an off meet at the County Invite last week, we told Brandon Hansen we needed 10 points out of him in the throws. We got....10 points from him as he took 4th in the Discus, throwing over 140' again, and taking 3rd in the Shot Put with a PR of 15.33m.

The night finished on the track with the 4 x 400 relay, and quite a bit of drama. We need to finish with 2 places ahead of Lake Forest in the event in order to beat them on the night. Unfortunately, we were seeded 3 places behind them, meaning we had an uphill battle to achieve our goal. On top of that, we needed to replace our anchor and fastest runner, Tector Connor, due to illness, so the odds were even more

stacked against our team of Kevin Moyer, Daniel Shannon, Nick Selimos, and Tyler Miller. You'd think that would be enough obstacles to overcome, but then Nick was tripped by another runner and fell to the ground during his leg. That should have sealed our fate, but it didn't, as Nick got up and finished hard, and Tyler held on to 5th place, while LF took 3rd. Mission accomplished!

Next Wednesday we compete at the IHSA Sectional Meet at Grayslake North for the chance to qualify for the State Meet. Hope you can all come out and support this team.




