Robert Knar is Mundelein's all-time leader in scoring and made three-pointers, finishing his career at MHS with 2,003 points.

He earned all-conference and all-area in both his freshman and sophomore seasons.

As a junior, Knar helped lead Mundelein to a 26-8 record while leading his team to the Class 4A Sectional final. That season he averaged 22.3 points, 7.6 rebounds and 6.1 assists while shooting 45 percent from the three-point line. He earned all-state honorable mention and first-team all-conference.

Knar suffered an ACL injury in 2012 and missed the first 20 games of his senior season before coming back to lead MHS to the 4A sectional semifinal. He received a full scholarship to play at Northern Iowa University. He also played at the University of Missouri Kansas City.

He is the son of former MHS Coach Richard Knar, also a member of the Mundelein Boys Basketball Hall of Fame.
