



Ballot Application for Current Election Only

Beginning 90 days before the election, the application is available by:

- Logging onto LakeVoterPower.info to submit an electronic application online or print a personalized PDF form to mail.
 - For the fastest processing method, complete an **electronic application**, select “Electronic Request” after log in and follow the prompts through to “Submit Request.” Your signature is not required, and you must complete an attestation.
 - If you wish to **print and mail** a personalized application to the Lake County Clerk’s office, select “Paper Form” after log in. Print, complete, sign, and mail or deliver your application to the Lake County Clerk’s office.
- Downloading and completing [this form](#) before mailing it to the Lake County Clerk's office,
- Calling the Lake County Clerk's Voting by Mail Department at 847-377-VOTE, or
- Emailing your name, address, and date of birth to votingbymail@lakecountyil.gov.
- Ballots are mailed starting 40 days before Election Day. (25 days for a Consolidated Election if there is a primary)



Deadlines

- Lake County Clerk’s office must receive your completed ballot application by 5 PM on the Thursday before Election Day.
- Your voted ballot must be hand delivered to the Lake County Clerk's office by 7 PM on Election Day, or it may be returned via mail with a postmark no later than Election Day and received at the Lake County Clerk's office no later than 14 days after Election Day.



Ballot

- Your ballot can be mailed to a temporary, alternate address.
- Your official ballot will be mailed through the U.S. Postal Service starting 40 days before an election.
